Scenario 1: Grace is a bright young child with post polio paralysis who uses a wheelchair and is currently not attending school.

What could be the role of government, OPDs and service providers to help her to be mainstreamed in education? **Scenario 2:** Blessings has a visual impairment and has a good small business, but he has been unable to access a loan from his local microfinance company to expand his services.

What could be the role of government, community members, and local leaders to support his mainstreaming? **Scenario 3:** Sheila is a teenager who has an intellectual disability. Her parents are very over-protective and don't let her participate in any community activities.

What could be the role of government, OPDs and service providers to help her to be mainstreamed? **Scenario 4:** Joseph is a young man of short stature who has been refused entry to University to study medicine.

What could be the role of his family members, OPDs, and local leaders to help him argue for his right of entry?
